

CRITERIA FOR INCLUSION ON THE CESKY TERRIER JUDGING LIST 2012-13

A3 List (Breed Specialists)

1. Minimum of 7 years in the breed and have the support of the Cesky Terrier Club.
2. To have judged at a Breed Club Show or a Breed Club Supported Entry Show.
3. To have judged the Breed at 5 Open or 3 Championship Shows without CC's
4. To have judged a minimum of 50 Cesky Terriers to the satisfaction of the Committee.
5. To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer, and passed the relevant examination on Kennel Club Regulations and Judging Procedures (KC policy as of 01/07/01)
6. To have attended at least one Breed Specific Breed Assessment run in accordance with the relevant (KC code of Best Practice and passed an examination and assessment where applicable (KC policy as of 01/07/01)
7. To have stewarded for a minimum period of 3 years and 12 shows.

A3 List (Non Specialists)

1. To have a minimum of 7 years judging experience in any one Breed and have the support of The Cesky Terrier Club.
2. To have judged at a Club Show or a Breed Club Supported Entry Show.
3. To have judged the Breed at 5 Open Shows or Championship Shows without CC's
4. To have judged 50 Cesky Terriers to the satisfaction of the Committee.
5. To have awarded CC's in at least one other Breed.
6. To have attended at least 2 Breed Judging Seminars and passed an Assessment.
7. To have stewarded for a minimum period of 3 years and 12 shows.

B List (Breed Specialists)

1. To have 5 years experience owning and exhibiting Cesky Terriers and have the support of The Cesky Terrier Club.
2. To have judged 35 Cesky Terriers to the satisfaction to the Committee
3. To have attended and passed a Breed Judging Assessment.

B List (Non Specialist)

1. To have a minimum of 5 years judging experience in any one Breed and have the support of the Cesky Terrier Club.
2. To have judged at least 35 Cesky Terriers to the satisfaction of the committee.
3. To have attended and passed a Breed Judging Assessment.

C List

For aspirant Judges who have shown an interest in the breed and have the support of The Cesky Terrier Club.

NB:- These criteria are guidelines only and will be subject to annual review.

All aspects of an application will be considered and the Cesky Terrier Club Committee reserve the Right to make a decision as to which list an applicant is assigned based on additional factors and information. The members vote to accept the proposed Judging List at each AGM, until such time the list is provisional.

Please note all information on your CV must be correct as spot checks will be made
It is Cesky Terrier policy, that a minimum period of eighteen months should elapse between
Championship/Supported entry shows judging appointments..
